WORK BEGINS SOON AT HAYS ON NEW BUILDING

Hays, Kanas., Jan. 23-Contract for

the new science hall at the State Teachers College here was given to the Gurtler Construction Company of Topeka, for \$116,104 last week, Work will be started at once and the building is to be completed about December 1, of this year. All the plumbing, heating and elec_ trical work is covered by a \$10.641 contract to the Salina Plumbing Com-

pany. An estimate of the size of the

building can be obtained from the amount of battleship linoleum to be laid in it. The floors will require

some \$6,000 worth of the covering. When a picture of the new building was shown in the Topeka Capi-

tal recently, Charles D. Cuthbert, state architect who designed the structure, expressed the opinion that

the hall will be the most up-to-date

science building in the state.
