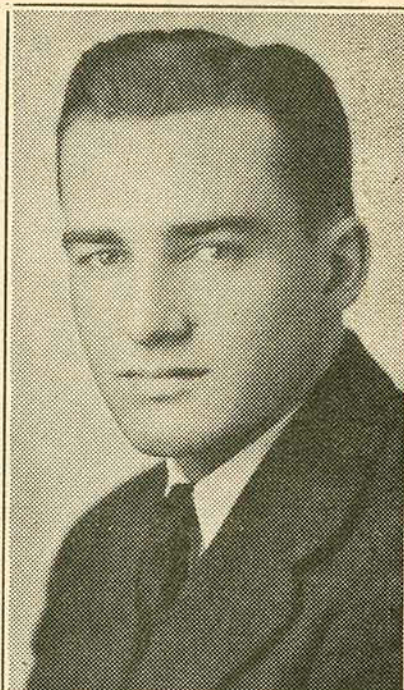

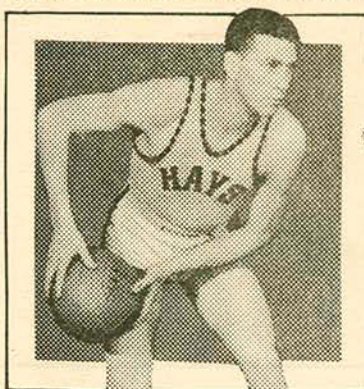

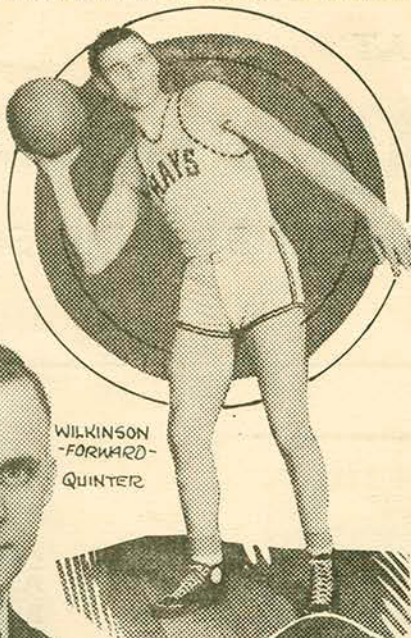

HAYS STATE WILL LOSE NINE SENIORS FROM THE 1933 SQUAD

"Bill" Bearly

"The grand old man of the Tigers," Leslie Edmonds once called "Bill" Bearly, who combines 30-odd years of wisdom with a 20-year-old enthusiasm and 178 pounds of drive, as he captains the 1933 Tigers from the full back position. Bearly is playing his fourth year. He comes from Atwood.

Virgil Brown

He is probably the fastest man on the Tiger football squad. Besides his two grid letters, Brown has won two letters at track, where he is a dash man. He plays quarterback, where he used to perform for Oakley high.

Gordon Farr

A jovial "soda squirt" who loses his joviality in a football game, Gordon Farr has earned three letters as a lineman at Hays State. Incidentally, he weighs 215 pounds, and comes from Natoma.

Bert Lane

A 152-pound full back—that's Bert Lane, from Bazine, who is earning his third letter as a member of the Tiger grid squad. Just another "tough little guy."

Willard Larson

He's big, is Willard Larson, from Sharon Springs, who weighs nearly 200 pounds. He is playing his third season with the Tigers at tackle.

Vernon Moreman

Powerful as he is big (and he weighs 203 pounds), Moreman is playing his fourth and last year on the Tiger eleven. He is a tackle and hails from Ross-ville.

Lawrence Myers

"Let's go, Tigers," is the rallying cry of Lawrence "Red" Myers, another Oakley product, who is playing his fourth year on the Tiger team as a tackle. He weighs 180 pounds.

Wyllis Neal

Wyllis Neal is playing his fourth season with the Tigers, where, as a triple threat who can pass, kick or lug the ball, he has been a fixture in the Hays backfield. Injuries have bothered him more than his opponents in his grid career. He comes from Scott Cty.

Herman Rothe

All Herman "Stud" Rothe lacks is size. Weighing less than 150 pounds, this "watch charm" guard has already earned one letter with the Tigers. Hays people who have also seen Roth in a boxing ring don't have to ask his "home folks" over at Bison how hard "Stud" can hit.

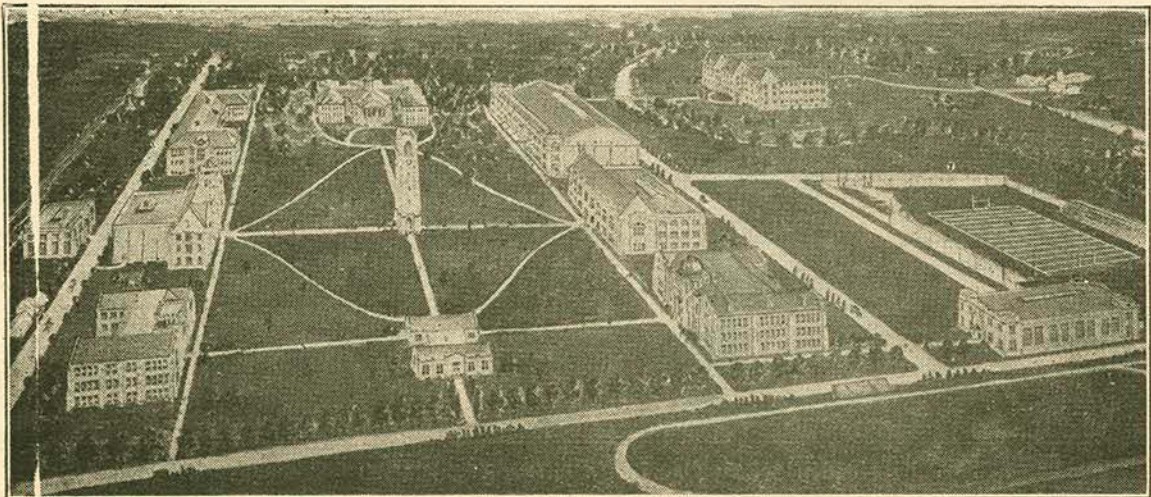
