1. COMMUNICATION

The intra-communication system is for the convenience of the residents. When there is a message for you, there will be two calls on your own floor and one on the all-floor call.

Floor meetings will be held twice a month following the RA meetings. House meetings will be called to inform the residents of any change in hall regulations and at any other time that it is deemed necessary.

To have a voice in student government, everyone should attend these meetings, discuss the issues and then vote.

2. RESIDENT ASSISTANTS

Resident Assistants have equal authority in all areas of the hall. Any resident who participates in obnoxious pranks will be subject to disciplinary action.

3. QUIET HOURS

From 7 p.m. to 7 a.m., please restrict the number of people in your room to roommates only, except in the case that the third man has a study problem.

Constant quiet hours will be maintained in the North and South libraries.

Noise during the day should be kept at a minimum. Attention should be given to being especially quiet late at night and early in the morning.

Persistent abuse of these regulations are subject to disciplinary action.

4. ROOM INSPECTION

Resident Assistants will inspect the rooms every Wednesday at their convenience. If the room fails to pass inspection for two consecutive weeks, the occupants will be asked to see the Head Resident.

5. DRINKING

Drinking is not allowed on State property. We do not approve of drinking nor its results. However, if you do drink, please return to the hall in an orderly manner. Troublesome offenders will be taken to the Hearing Committee.

6. GAMBLING

There is to be no gambling on State property. Any infractions in this area will be handled by the Dean of Men.

Card playing in the recreation room only, Monday through Thursday evenings until 10:30 p.m.

If poker chips or anything that represents money is used, it will be assumed that gambling is taking place.

7. MISCELLANEOUS

Clothing is not to be left in the bathrooms, nor is it to be hung on a venetian shade.

Light bulbs will be replaced by the RA. Please report specific repair needs and they will be cared for as soon as possible.

Hall lights will be turned off at 9 p.m.

When illness occurs, report it to your RA or to the Head Resident.

Dress in the main lounge is casual (no cut-offs, dirty sweat shirts, etc.).

House fees are \$2.00 per semester.

Please register your over-night guests at the desk and pay for their accommodations there.
