Dear President Lewis:

I am inclosing herewith a drawing showing the revised detail for the air cooled floors.

Instead of using the cast iron tee bars - we would use 5x8x12 inch hollow tile set on the five inch bed, and then place the fire brick floor on this material. The damper control would be as originally shown.

This method would save considerable expense and prevent any delay in starting the brickwork.
