WICHITA STATE UNIVERSITY AND FORT HAYS STATE UNIVERSITY
EXTENSION CENTER AGREEMENT

In consideration of the establishment and maintenance of the Basic and Advanced Courses of the Army Reserve Officers' Training Corps unit of Wichita State University at Fort Hays State University, it is hereby agreed between the governing authorities of these institutions to the following:

1. Contingent upon the fulfillment of all promises enumerated in paragraph 2 following, the governing authorities of Wichita State University agree as follows:

a. To the offering of the Basic and Advanced Military Science Courses by the Department of Military Science on the campus of Fort Hays State University.

b. The credit associated with the courses offered at Fort Hays State University will be considered as resident credit at Fort Hays State University and may be applied to a degree program at Wichita State University or transferred to an institution that grants credit for Military Science.

c. The enrollment fee for such course will be that normally charged per credit hour of instruction as established by Fort Hays State University.

d. Provide all textbooks, uniforms, training aids, and instructional materials at Fort Hays State University in support of ROTC instruction.

e. Provide necessary administrative support for the operation of the Military Science program.

2. Contingent upon the fulfillment of all promises enumerated in paragraph 1 above, the governing authorities of Fort Hays State University agree as follows:

a. To require each student enrolled in any Army Reserve Officers' Training Corps course to devote a number of hours to military instruction prescribed by the Secretary of the Army.

b. Make available, without charge, necessary classrooms, equipment, administrative offices, storage space, government vehicle parking space, staff parking space, and other required facilities in the same manner and at the same level as that provided similar activities/departments within the institution.

c. Provide adequate secretarial, janitorial, and communication services, printing and publications, utilities, and grounds upkeep to the ROTC instructor group personnel on the same basis as that provided similar activities/departments within the institution.

d. Nondiscrimination with respect to admission or subsequent treatment of students on the basis of sex, race, color, or national origin.

e. The Professor of Military Science or his designated Assistant Professor of Military Science shall have access to the student records of all students enrolled in ROTC at Fort Hays State University.


f. Award academic credit applicable toward graduation for the successful completion of academic courses which are part of the Military Science curriculum. Academic credit will be judged by the institution under the same procedures and criteria as for other institutional courses.

3. It is mutually understood and agreed as follows:

a. The extension center students shall, for this course, be considered as members of the Wichita State University Corps of Cadets, and as such may participate in any military function. Further, such students are eligible for participation in WSU ROTC extra curricular activities.


b. This agreement shall become effective 1 February 1980 and may be terminated by either Wichita State University or Fort Hays State University, upon giving one academic year's notice to the other in writing.
