Gillogly/Engel Bill No. 08/S/125 4/24/08 Senate Affairs Originated By: Senate Affairs Presented By: The Senate Affairs committee, issued with the task of annually reviewing Whereas: the Student Government Association Constitution, has researched the need to make amendments to the Constitution; and The constitution is in need of updates for clarity, consistency and the Noting: removal clauses that are no longer effective; and Realizing: The absence of these updates could be detrimental to the organization in enforcing its policies and procedures; and Recommending: To strike Article III, Divisions A & B, and replace with the following language: A. Any student that is enrolled in at least one on-campus credit hour at Fort Hays State University, and has paid the Student Activity Fee, shall be considered a member of the Student Government Association. B. Any member of the Student Government Association that is considered full-time status by Fort Hays State University, with a 2.00 grade point average (on a 4.00 grade point average scale) is eligible for election to, or appointment to, a Student Government executive branch position, legislative branch position or judicial branch position. [Aug. 07 p. 3]; and Also To strike "(must be accepted to Teacher Education Program)" from Recommending: Article IV, Division B, Section 1, subsection a), subsection (1), subsection (f) [Aug. 07 p. 8]; and Also To add the words "A special election can be held in conjunction with a regularly scheduled election" as Article V, Division A, Recommending: Section 6, subsection c), subsection 22), subsection (a) [Aug. 07 p. 22]; and Therefore: Be it resolved by a two-thirds vote of the Student Senate and the signature of the Student Body President, that the amendments to the Constitution be presented to the Student Body for ratification during a special election which will be held on May 7 & 8, 2008.
