State Vehicle Rate Increase

Due to the rising cost of maintaining University fleet vehicles, the Motor Pool will be implementing a minimum fee for all vehicles that travel under 50 miles per day, effective *July 1, 2016 (FY 17)*.

CARS: 23 cents x 50 miles = \$11.50 per day

MINI VAN: 30 cents x 50 miles = \$15.00 per day

8 & 12-PSG VAN: 41 cents x 50 miles = \$20.50

RYDER TRUCK: \$20 per day

Charges for any trips over 50 miles will remain the same as in the past, miles traveled and fuel used.

Please submit a transportation requisition in advance for all travel, including the Ryder truck.

For assistance in figuring costs for any trips over 50 miles, current fees will remain in place:

Cars: 23 cents per mile plus fuel used

Mini Van: 30 cents per mile plus fuel used

8 & 12-Psg Van: 41 cents per mile plus fuel used

Please attach any fuel receipts to the clip board provided in vehicle.
