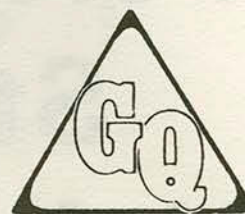

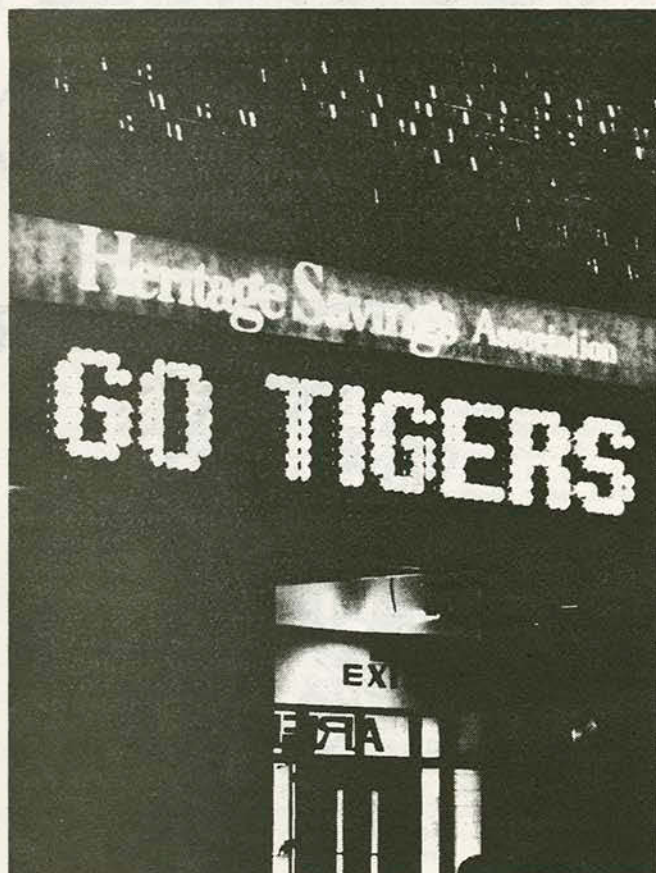

TIGER BOOSTER CLUBS

Contributors to the Fort Hays State University athletic program can join one of several booster clubs depending on the amount of their contribution.

The Black and Gold Club is for contributions of \$10 to \$35. Features of this club include a membership card entitling the holder admittance to Tiger Rooms, schedules of athletic events, the athletic newsletter, priority on purchase of football and basketball season tickets and special events and travel.

Contributions of \$36 to \$99 denote the Varsity Club level. Included in this club are all the features of the Black and Gold Club plus a higher priority on the purchase of season tickets.

A \$100 to \$499 donation enables contributors to be classified as Century Club members. Besides the above-mentioned features, members receive a leatherette plaque with name, reserved parking space of athletic events, name listed on Athletic Board and a car decal.

All-American Club status is achieved with a contribution of \$500 to \$999. Club members, in addition to the features of the Century Club, are entitled to varsity brochures, coaches letters and after-game parties.

The highest level of membership is the Flying Tiger Club for contributions of \$1000 or more. Flying Tiger memberships have top priority on purchase of football and basketball season tickets, VIP parking, receive a special plaque and attend a special dinner. They are also eligible for all the features of the other clubs.

A popular booster club at Fort Hays State University is the Tiger Beef Club. Membership in the Beef Club is awarded to interested boosters who contribute a steer or cash (\$250 or more which is used to buy a steer) each year. Proceeds from the sale of such livestock go directly into the department's budget. Beef Club members receive similar benefits as do members of the Century Club.
