Whereas: The Student Affairs Committee; issued with the task of studying issues and concerns of the students of Fort Hays State University, has been made aware of an issue regarding the needs of Fort Hays State University students; and

Noting: That the Committee to Review and Rethink the Structure of the University examined and analyzed a proposed name change of the institution and their report has recommended the change as a high priority; and

Also Noting: That Dr. Edward Hammond has included the proposal in the design elements of the Dare to Dream Initiatives document; and

Also Noting: That the student body of FHSU has displayed a strong opposition to the proposed name change by voicing their opinions through a variety of mediums including telephone calls, face-to-face visits, SGA open forum, and a multitude of electronic communications; and

Also Noting: That the Student Affairs Committee of the Student Government Association has concluded through their research that the costs (both financial and non-financial) outweigh the benefits of changing the name of the institution, and compiled with the students' grievances, the committee further supports the student opposition.

Therefore: Be it resolved by a majority vote of the Student Senate and the signature of the Student Body President that the students of Fort Hays State University strongly oppose the proposal of changing the name of the institution from Fort Hays State University to any of the recommended names.
