Whereas:	The Legislative and Political Action Committee, issued with the task of reviewing student fee increases, has researched a proposal for the addition of a student Tiger Wellness Center fee; and	
Noting:	That a \$1.00 fee would greatly benefit the Tiger Wellness Center with maintenance, employment and equipment costs, and that the fees would allow for the saving of excess funds to be used for the building of a larger facility; and
