Whereas: The Student Government Association Constitution gives the President of the Student Government Association the power to give a waiver to any organization that is not recognized as a Student Organization by the Student Organizations Committee in Article IV, Division A, Section 1, subsection a), subsection (1), subsection (l), and

Realizing: That a waiver is needed for a non S.O.C. recognized organization to receive funding through the appropriations process according to Article V, Division A, Section 1, subsection b), subsection (1), and

Noting: That the Student Government Association President has received and reviewed a waiver request from the following organization and has deemed them suitable to receive student fee money through the appropriations process to support their operations:

Tiger Wellness Center

Therefore: Be it enacted by a two-thirds vote of the Student Senate and the signature of the Student Body President, that the above organization receives a waiver, thereby enabling them to be given consideration for funding through any normal means as defined in the Constitution of the Student Government Association for the 2007-2008 academic year.
