Hughes/Engel Waiver No. 09/S/100 01/29/09 Office of the President Originated by: Presented by: Office of the President Whereas: The Student Government Association Constitution gives the President of the Student Government Association the power to give a waiver to any organization that is not recognized as a Student Organization by the Student Organizations Committee in Article IV, Division A, Section 1, subsection a), subsection (1), subsection (I), and Realizing: That a waiver is needed for a non-S.O.C. recognized organization to receive funding through the allocations process according to Article V. Division A, Section 7, subsection b), subsection (1), and Noting: That the Student Government Association President has received and reviewed waiver requests from the following organizations and has deemed them suitable to receive student fee money through the allocations process to support their operations: American Democracy Project **Special Events Committee** Center for Student Involvement Tiger Tots Nurtury Center FHSU Athletic Bands / Tiger Debs **Tiger Transport** Homecoming Committee **Tiger Wellness Center** LEAD (Collegiate Leadership) **Tigers in Service** Therefore: Be it enacted by a two-thirds vote of the Student Senate and the signature of the Student Body President, that the above organizations receive a waiver, thereby enabling them to be given consideration for funding through any normal means as defined in the Constitution of the Student Government Association for the 2009-2010 academic year (FY10).
