from residence hall income. Regent Hostetler moved and Regent Slawson seconded a motion to approve the request. Motion carried.

FINAL PLANS - Regents Center - KU

The University of Kansas requested that the final plans and contract documents for the new Regents Center in Overland Park, Kansas, be approved and that the Director of Architectural Services be requested to review the plans and specifications and that the Director of Purchasing take bids for the construction contract. A memorandum was prepared by Board staff to describe the project site, design and budget. The total project cost is \$6.0 million and the project is expected to be out for bids in October of 1990. Regent Harman moved and Regent Palmer seconded a motion to approve the request. Motion carried.

LEGISLATIVE FACILITIES REQUEST - Nuclear Reactor Shell - KU

The University of Kansas requested authority from the Board, 1992 Legislature and the Governor to appropriate \$750,000 for FY 1993 for engineering and construction to comply with federal decommissioning requirements for the unfueled nuclear reactor on the Lawrence campus. Staff explained the need for a FY 1993 request a year ahead of schedule in order to satisfy federal licensing requirements of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission. The request to the 1992 Legislature is expected to be \$750,000 for decommissioning and completely removing the massive concrete shielding structure that surrounded the reactor. Regent Slawson moved and Regent Sexton seconded a motion to approve the request. Motion carried.

NAME DESIGNATION - Rodeo Club Arena - FHSU

Fort Hays State University requested authority to name the Rodeo Club Arena for Doug Philip, a local rancher, faithful supporter and charter member of the FHSU Rodeo Club. Regent Jeter moved and Regent Palmer seconded a motion to approve the request. Motion carried.

STATEWIDE PRIORITY LISTING OF CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS FOR FY 1992

Regent Hostetler moved and Regent Slawson seconded a motion to approve the Statewide Priority Listing for the FY 1992 Capital Improvements Request to the 1991 Legislature dated September 20, 1990. Motion carried.

KUMC CENSUS AND FINANCIAL REPORT

Executive Vice-Chancellor Clawson reported that revenues to the Hospital Revenue Fund were \$397,000 above estimates for the first two months of FY 1991. However, he cautioned that inpatient days have declined by 1,318 compared to the first two months of last fiscal year. The Medical Center is investigating reasons for
