

## Tonight's Game

Fort Hays State's basketball team, defending Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference champion, opens its 1971-72 season tonight against a strong Benedictine College squad.

FHS fans will remember Benedictine as St. Benedict's College. Earlier this year two Atchison colleges, St. Benedict's and St. Scholastica, joined together to form Benedictine College.

Although the school name is different the basketball personnel is basically the same as a year ago. The Ravens return three lettermen from last year's squad which posted a 15-8 record and entered the District 10 Playoffs.

Heading the list of returnees is senior forward Chic Downing who was the Ravens' top scorer last season with a 20.8 points per game average. He also grabbed 10.5 rebounds per contest as a junior. Other returning letter winners are senior forward Dave Baltuska and junior guard Jackie Lee.

Senior Bill O'Connor recorded varsity playing time last season and will add depth to the guard and forward positions this year. Freshman Tim Hammon and Hillary Howard are expected to add strength to the Ravens' front line.

After the loss of six lettermen, second year head coach Tom Colwell feels that the team's weakness is at the forward position "where there is a lack of size and height."

The head mentor considers the "overall team quickness as a solid asset" and he believes that "the team's success will depend on how the young front line comes through."

## A Look Ahead

Kearney (Neb.) State will furnish the competition for the Tigers in their second home basketball game at 7:30 p.m. Saturday.

FHS downed the Antelopes in the opening game last season 101-72, while Kearney reversed the score in the second meeting with a 102-71 victory. FHS leads the series between the two schools, 27-6.

Although Kearney lost three starters from last year's squad which posted a 17-8 record, the Nebraskans have high hopes for the 1971-72 campaign.

The Antelope coaches will depend on seven returning lettermen and "the best freshman crop ever" for a good season.

Head coach Jerry Hueser will count on senior center Roger Ahrens, senior guard John Kropp, junior guard Jerry Willis and freshman forward Tom Kropp to lead the team this season.

This year's squad is the tallest in Antelope history and "if injuries don't strike" the coaches believe "the team could out-do last year's record which was the best ever at Kearney."

According to Hueser, some of the new Antelope players to watch are "Tom Kropp, an all-America basketball player in high school; Alan Lee, who returns this season after passing up basketball his junior year; and Elton Roland, a sure outside shooter."






**Duane Rauhut,**


