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Faculty Meeting
Oct. 21, 1953

Dr. McCartney presided at the meeting, and presented three recommendations of the Faculty Senate for approval.

Recommended by the Senate on September 17 that the pre-summer session be discontinued immediately. Motion was made by Dr. Thompson, seconded by Miss Morrison, that this recommendation be approved. Motion carried unaimously.

Recommended by the Senate on September 24 that the organization UNESCO be given activity credit. Motion was made by Mr. Start, seconded by Dr. Thompson, that this recommendation be approved. Motion carried unanimously.

Recommended by the Senate on October 15, that the summer session schedule as shown in the minutes of that day be adopted. Motion was made by Dr. Welty, seconded by Dr. Thompson that this recommendation be approved. Motion carried.

Dr. McCartney announced that the Reveille staff is asking for faculty pictures, if a change is to be made, by November 15. A special price is available at Ekeys, the same as for students.

President Cunningham expressed his thanks to faculty members for their work in connection with the eight AACTE evaluation schedules, which were now completed and ready for the visiting committee. He also asked the cooperation of faculty members in the matter of counseling and advising students, and urged all members who have student advisees to make an effort to visit with them if they have not already done so since classes started.

Dr. Stopher presented and discussed the evaluation schedules prepared by AACTE committee No. I. He made the motion that the objectives as presented by the committee and printed on page 19 of the current catalogue be adopted by this faculty as the objectives of Fort Hays Kansas State College. Motion was seconded and carried.

Mrs. Simons present the report of AACTE committee No. II, and discussed the report and the materials presented therewith.
