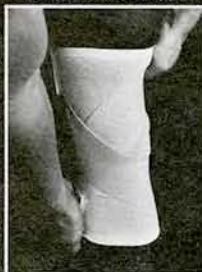

## **GERALD TOMANEK**

**FORT HAYS STATE UNIVERSITY PRESIDENT**

The Number One fan of Fort Hays State Athletics is Dr. Gerald (Jerry) Tomanek. Dr. Tomanek and his lovely wife, Ardis, are virtually permanent fixtures at Tiger home football and basketball games. The couple also attend many road contests as well.

Since 1947, Dr. Tomanek has been a part of Fort Hays State University serving in several capacities. On January 17, 1976, Dr. Tomanek was named the seventh President of Fort Hays State University. Dr. Tomanek holds two degrees from the University and has his doctorate in Botany from the University of Nebraska.

Several honors have been bestowed on the expert of grassland ecology and range management. The highest of which came in the early Spring of 1979 when Governor John Carlin decreed Dr. Tomanek as "Kansan of the Year."

Dr. Tomanek recognizes the need for strong academics and the need for excellent administration in an institution of higher learning. The President knows also the importance that athletics can play in institutional success.

"I am very proud of our total athletic program, and it is an integral part of our total university," said Dr. Tomanek. "Young men and women are very fortunate to participate in intercollegiate athletics and can learn valuable lessons like friendship and teamwork in a way that will enhance their horizons."

Administrative duties are nothing new to Thompson as he has been in private business and served as Athletic Director at Ardmore High School in Oklahoma. Coach Thompson served as head football coach of two high schools, one college, and three major Universities before coming to Fort Hays State. 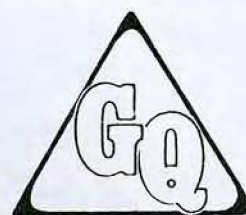

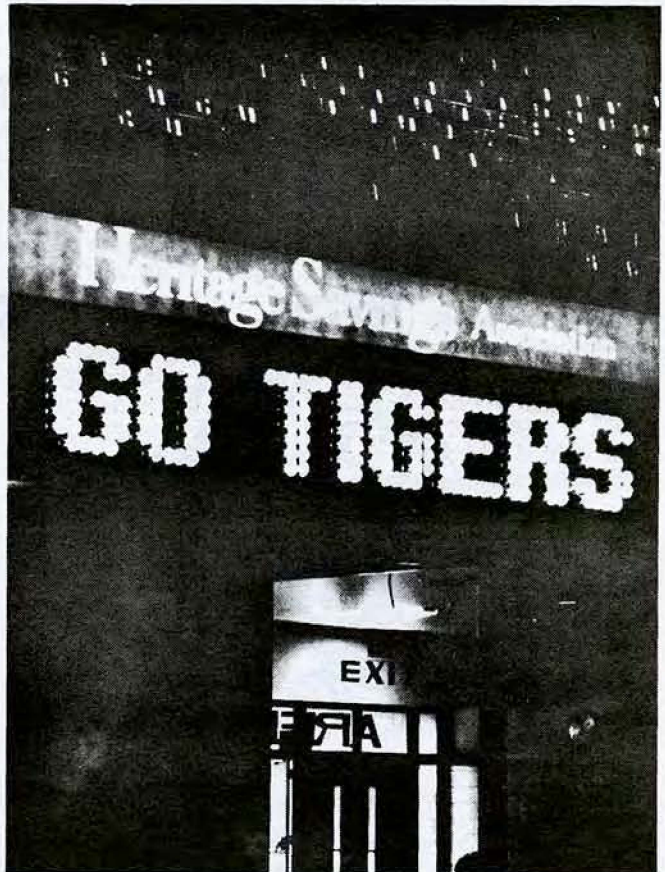

## TIGER BOOSTER CLUBS

Contributors to the Fort Hays State University athletic program can join one of several booster clubs depending on the amount of their contribution.

The Black and Gold Club is for contributions of \$10 to \$35. Features of this club include a membership card entitling the holder admittance to Tiger Rooms, schedules of athletic events, the athletic newsletter, priority on purchase of football and basketball season tickets and special events and travel.

Contributions of \$36 to \$99 denote the Varsity Club level. Included in this club are all the features of the Black and Gold Club plus a higher priority on the purchase of season tickets.

A \$100 to \$499 donation enables contributors to be classified as Century Club members. Besides the above-mentioned features, members receive a leatherette plaque with name, reserved parking space of athletic events, name listed on Athletic Board and a car decal.

All-American Club status is achieved with a contribution of \$500 to \$999. Club members, in addition to the features of the Century Club, are entitled to varsity brochures, coaches letters and after-game parties.

The highest level of membership is the Flying Tiger Club for contributions of \$1000 or more. Flying Tiger memberships have top priority on purchase of football and basketball season tickets, VIP parking, receive a special plaque and attend a special dinner. They are also eligible for all the features of the other clubs.

A popular booster club at Fort Hays State University is the Tiger Beef Club. Membership in the Beef Club is awarded to interested boosters who contribute a steer or cash (\$250 or more which is used to buy a steer) each year. Proceeds from the sale of such livestock go directly into the department's budget. Beef Club members receive similar benefits as do members of the Century Club.

# The 1980-81 Fort Hays State Basketball Outlook

Fort Hays State basketball coach Joe Rosado is smiling these days and at first glance, the reasons aren't real apparent.

After all, Rosado must find replacements for three starters from last year's 17-16 team that finished tied for fourth in the CSIC with a 7-7 mark. Gone are point guard and leading scorer Steve Griffin, the team's leading rebounder, center Eddie Meltz, and veteran forward Rich Rust.

Griffin averaged 14 points a game and dished out 136 assists last year. Meltz pulled down eight rebounds per outing and scored 12 a game while Rust chipped in 10 points and five rebounds each time he stepped on the court.

Three rather large voids to fill.

But Rosado is still optimistic of the Tiger's chances this season, his fourth at the Tiger helm.

"I feel real good about our prospects this season," Rosado said. "I'm very pleased with our level of talent. I don't know what the other teams are going to have, but, we had one of the leading programs in District 10 last year and I'm sure we'll be up there among the best this year as well. That was one of our goals four years ago, and I'm pleased we have reached that point."

The reasons for Rosado's optimism are three-fold — a wealth of returning talent, a banner recruiting year, and perhaps most importantly, Mark Wilson.

Wilson missed all of last season with a knee injury but is back and ready to resume his assault on the Tiger record book. The Columbus, Ohio native is already the fourth leading scorer in Tiger history and is only 275 points away from FHSU career leader Mike Pauls' record of 1,492.

His career scoring average at FHSU is 20.6, including a 19.9 average two years ago. Wilson is also the Tigers' career leader in assists with 351, including 14 in a game two years ago against Hastings. The margin will undoubtedly widen considerably before the 1980-81 campaign is finished.

"Mark is even better than he was before he got hurt," Rosado said of his 6-1 senior All-America prospect. "He benefited greatly from sitting out last year by watching the game from a different perspective."

"He's improved his outside shooting considerably and has added a whole new dimension to his game. He can hurt the opposition in so many ways. He's the premier guard in the CSIC and District 10 and I wouldn't trade him for anyone."

Two years ago Wilson was chosen for Little All-America honorable mention honors by the Associated Press.

But, Wilson isn't the only reason Rosado is expecting big things from his Tigers this season.

The Tigers return two starters and two part-time starters, who along with three other returning lettermen, give Rosado valuable returning experience.

Guard Max Hamblin returns after averaging 13 points a game last year. The 6-0 senior demonstrated a keen eye from long range last year and is a threat to score from anywhere on the court.

Starting forward Lionel "Zuke" Hamer, a strong, 6-4 senior, also returns after scoring 10 points a game last year and pulling down six rebounds. Hamer was a dominant figure inside for the Tigers the second half of last season.

Six-foot senior swingman Bill Giles is back after a solid 1979-80 campaign where he averaged seven points and three rebounds a game as a part-time starter.

The Tiger's second part-time starter is 6-8 sophomore Rege Klitzke, who played well in his initial season with FHSU. Klitzke hails from Russell and averaged five points and three rebounds a game last year.

Senior Wayne Garr, a smooth-moving, quick 6-2 guard returns. Garr may be the fastest player on the team and is one of the teams' top defensive players because of his quickness.

Senior center Rocco Margosian also returns, and at 6-11, will give the Tigers a quality big man inside.

Tom Wikoff, a 6-4 senior forward is also back and is expected to battle for a starting role this winter. Wikoff missed most of last season with a hand injury, but appears to be healthy. Wikoff transferred to Fort Hays from Kansas Wesleyan last year.

"As a group, I haven't been satisfied with our returning people since I've been here," Rosado said, "but I am this year. We've got some outstanding players returning. They're the kind of people I like to have around."

During the off-season, Rosado lured two gems to FHSU who will make their presence known before the spring thaw in April.

Joining the Tigers from the start will be 6-4 freshman center Cesar Fantauzzi, who hails from Puerto Rico. Fantauzzi played on the Puerto Rican Pan-American team and has the ability to jump with the big boys inside.

"Cesar can jump and passes the ball extremely well," Rosado said. "He'll be one of the best in the District before the season is over."

Rosado also netted another sky-high leaper in 6-5 Manhattan College transfer Dino Larry. Larry hails from Poughkeepsie, NY and is noted for his quickness.

"Dino is one of the most outstanding players I've ever recruited," Rosado proudly said. "You won't see many players like him at this level."

Larry doesn't become eligible until second semester, but will play both guard and forward in 1981.

Other new faces on the Tiger roster this season will include 6-3 freshman forward Roger Casey, who played his high school basketball at Hays High for Coach Roger Robinson.

Casey was chosen the Outstanding Male Athlete at HHS last year and is following in the footsteps of his father Gary, who also played basketball at FHSU.

Ell-Saline High produce John Johnson also joins the Tigers this year after helping the Cardinals to the Class IA state title last year. The 6-2 Johnson has amazing jumping ability and is expected to see considerable action for the Tigers.

Other new faces on the Tiger roster this winter will include 6-6 freshman forward Gary Venhuizen from Morrison, IL; 6-1 freshman guard Mike Decker from Canton-Galva High; 6-2 sophomore guard Dave Lambert from Goodland; and 6-4 sophomore forward Ken Watts, who played at Hays High two years ago.



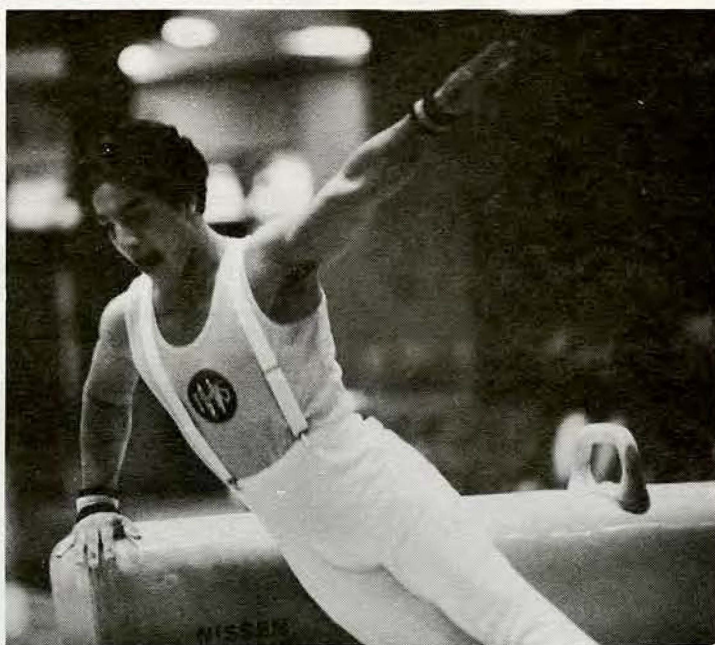
