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FACULTY MEETING

December 12, 1955

Dean McCartney presided and presented the following recommendations from the Faculty Senate all of which were approved.

It was recommended that the following method for figuring the grade point be used: All grades received and recorded on the transcript for the preceding semester, or for any other period regardless of the use to be made of the grade index shall be computed upon a single scale as follows: A - 3, B - 2, C - 1, D - 0, and U - minus 1; and that this should apply on all grades recorded after September 1, 1956.

It is recommended that the Fort Hays Kansas State College continue its present policy with regard to the transfer of Junior College credits.

It was recommended that the same schedule of class hours be used for the coming summer as was used last summer which is, classes begin at 7:30 a.m., 8:40, 9:50, 11:00, 1:00 p.m., 2:10, 3:20, and 4:30; and that the classes scheduled at 7:30 should be those having another section at some other time during the day; and that the double periods should be the first and second, or the third and fourth periods.

It was recommended that the afternoon classes in the regular semesters of 1956-1957 be scheduled on the hour, 1:00, 2:00, 3:00, and 4:00 in order to provide one additional period.

The faculty again discussed and agreed to the plan of submitting 1956-1957 schedule of classes by January 10, and printed schedules ready by June 1.

Dr. Cunningham reported on the organization and personnel of the White House Conference, and some high points. The discussion will be continued at the next faculty meeting, January 10.
