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FACULTY MEETING

April 16, 1956

Mr. Carl Malmberg was present and asked for a few minutes time in which to present the plans of the Alumni Association in connection with the spring activities, and the fall Homecoming. He called attention to the alumni club dinner to be held at the Lamer Hotel, April 26, and the program for Homecoming.

Dr. McCartney presented the recommendation of the Faculty Senate, March 14, as follows: "All transfer students will be expected to validate credit in any skill courses which are transferred; and that this policy shall be effective as of June 1, 1956." Motion was made, seconded and carried that this recommendation be approved.

The Dean then called attention to the statement regarding absences from class attached to the Faculty Bulletin of April 11. There was considerable discussion regarding the procedure followed in this regard.

Dr. Moreland was then asked to make a brief statement concerning the Scholarship program, the work of the committee, and the type of scholarships, and sources.

Dr. Coder told about the meeting of the Institute for Research re: Exceptional Children which he recently attended, and the progress made by this committee in studying this problem.

Mr. Rematore asked the faculty for recommendation of students for the Honors Seminar next year.

President Cunningham discussed the problems facing the college of larger enrollments, larger classes, use of facilities, the longer class day, the use of committees, budgetary matters, final examination period, criticism of policies in other colleges, housing facilities, federal loans for housing and student union, and other matters pertinent to the problems of the college at this time.
