This is Fort Hays State University

Founded in 1902 on the Plains of Western Kansas, Fort Hays State University is the second youngest of the six state universities of higher education.

From an exciting beginning, when 34 students were greeted by two faculty members and a 19-course curriculum, our University has grown to a student body of 5,500, a faculty of nearly 300, a support staff of 250 and a curriculum comprised of 1,500 courses.

Fort Hays State University is one of six state-assisted universities governed by a Board of Regents appointed by the Governor of the State of Kansas.

The main campus of FHSU sits on 200 of the 4,160 acres owned by the state of Kansas and deeded to the University. Winding Big Creek, with its shady, grassy banks, traverses the campus and provides not only a tranquil, conducive learning atmosphere, but also a natural laboratory for students in the biological sciences. Our campus has often been called the prettiest in Kansas.

Fort Hays State University is located in Hays, the largest city in northwest Kansas. A progressive city of 17,500 people, Hays is an old cow town on the Union

Pacific railroad. The old and the new blend beautifully to form a city that is small enough you can feel comfortable in, yet is large enough to provide culture and shopping facilities second to none.

The University is comprised of five schools: Arts and Sciences; Business; Education; Graduate; and Nursing, and 24 departments.

FHSU is academically superior to many comparable universities and is richly endowed by heritage and tradition. A recent survey of our students showed that while there are a multitude of reasons why students come to our University, their overwhelming response was "because of the University's reputation for academic excellence."

Fort Hays State University supports one of the most extensive intercollegiate sports programs of any comparable size college or university in America. More than 350 athletes annually compete in 11 men's and women's sports. FHSU is a member of the strong Central States Intercollegiate Conference, a league made up of eight schools from the states of Kansas, Missouri and Nebraska.

Gross Memorial Coliseum

Gross Memorial Coliseum is the home of the Fort Hays State "Fighting Tigers." The 7,000-seat arena was finished in August of 1973 at a cost of 7 million dollars. The Tigers made the move across campus from Sheridan Coliseum which seated 2,000. Paul "Busch" Gross is the namesake of the Coliseum. Gross coached basketball at FHSU from 1930 to 1946 and totaled 150 wins and 88 losses in 14 seasons.

The Coliseum has most recently been the site of three District 10 Championship wins for Bill Morse's teams. In the Morse era, the Tigers have compiled a five-year record of 85-6 for a winning percentage of .934 at Gross Memorial Coliseum. Fort Hays State led the nation (non-NCAA institutions) in home attendance during the 1984-85 and 1986-87 seasons.

In the first game ever played at Gross Memorial Coliseum on November 30, 1973, Fort Hays State defeated East Central State (OK) University, 74-68. Chuck Brehm coached the first team to play at GMC and his team won 11 of 14 contests that first season. Also in that historical first game, Greg Standish scored a game high 20 points and nine rebounds.

M.C. Cunningham Hall is part of the total Health, Physical Education and Recreation/Athletic complex at Fort Hays State. Cunningham Hall houses HPER offices, classrooms, a swimming pool, four full-sized gymnasiums, eight handball/racquetball courts, a weight room, two dance studios, a wrestling room and a gymnastics room.

Gross Memorial Coliseum is a multi-purpose facility that hosts concerts (seating for 10,000), the KSHSAA State 1A Basketball Tournament, the KSHSAA State 1A-2A-3A Wrestling Championships and indoor track meets. The Coliseum houses the FHSU athletic offices, a large athletic training room, locker rooms, concession stands, press box and the newest addition is the Fields Weight Room which features full nautilus equipment, mirrors and a full-time supervisor.

Fort Hays State University takes pride in its basketball facility and sees it as one of the most modern and comprehensive complexes in the country.

Edward H. Hammond - President



Dr. Edward H. Hammond was named the eighth President of Fort Hays State University on April 18, 1987. Hammond, who was born in McAllen, TX, was Vice President for Student Affairs and associate professor of education at the University of Louisville before assuming his new position.

He succeeded Dr. Gerald Tomanek as president at FHSU. Tomanek, who had been associated with the University since 1938 as a student, teacher and president, guided the University's fortunes since 1976.

Hammond brings a wealth of experience to the Hays campus. Prior to his responsibilities at Louisville, he was Vice President for Student Affairs and assistant professor in the School of Education at Seton Hall University in South Orange, N.J.

Other prior positions were Assistant to the President for Student Relations and assistant professor in the Department of Higher Education at Southern Illinois (Carbondale) University; Assistant Dean of Students at

the Carbondale campus; counselor at the University of Missouri-Columbia, and Director of Student Affairs at the North Central Campus of Purdue University.

Hammond's honors include being named to Who's Who in Education, Who's Who in the South, Outstanding Young Men of America, the President's Commission on the Rights and Freedoms of Students, and the Inter Association Task Force on College Alcohol Abuse and Misuse.

Hammond said upon his appointment that he is impressed with the innovative programs in place at FHSU. "The Small Business Development Center, a program which has successfully helped develop small business in western Kansas, the Honors Program, the computerized writing analysis program in the Department of English, and the \$3 million federal grant that is enabling the library to become completely computerized, are just a few of the many outstanding programs which have brought FHSU not only state wide recognition but national attention as well," said Hammond. "I'm looking forward to working at Fort Hays State University."

He and his wife, Vivian, are the parents of three children, daughters Kelly and Julie and son Lance.

Robert Van Poppel Director of Athletics



Robert Van Poppel, who brought with him strong and successful experience in the educational and private sectors, was named to the post of director of athletics at Fort Hays State University on April 22, 1985.

Van Poppel uses a guideline in life of "strive for excellence, no excuses and no compromises." In his two years at Fort Hays

State, Van Poppel has taken steps to insure that our athletes are getting along well academically as well as competing for conference, district and national honors. He has made great strides to improve the athletic department's relationship with its former letter winners by reviving a dormant K-Club membership and implementing a Varsity Club for persons who have lettered since 1975. Van Poppel also was instrumental in forming and inducting the first 20 members into the Tiger Sports Hall of Fame.


A native of Ohio, Van Poppel was highly successful in the insurance business in Richmond, IN, before coming to FHSU. His administrative background in athletics dates back to Earlham College in Richmond where he was athletic director from 1977 to 1982. He coordinated the entire program for a small liberal arts college with an enrollment of 1,300. He was responsible for a total of 16 varsity sports.

Van Poppel has also held posts as a coach and health, physical education and recreation instructor at Chadron (NE) State College, 1973-77; Wittenburg (OH) University, 1970-73; and the University of Wisconsin-Whitewater, 1969-70. He has also held positions in athletics at the high school level in Ohio.

A four-time letter winner in basketball as a collegian, Van Poppel received his B.S. degree in Education from Bowling Green State University in 1966. He earned a master's degree in Education from Ohio University in 1968. Indiana University was the site of advance graduate work in administration for Van Poppel.

Bob and his wife, Lynne, reside in Hays and are the parents of five children: Andra (16), Bret (18), Clele (12), Helen (26) and Tisha (16).

Bill Morse has quickly become one of the premiere NAIA coaches in the country. A record of 150-27 (good enough for a winning percentage of .847), back-to-back NAIA national titles (1983-84, 84-85) and a 27-3 post-season mark have all been a part of the five-year Morse era at Fort Hays State.

Since he took charge of the FHSU program, the list of honors and achievements for Morse has been long and distinguished. Following his first year as head coach of the Tigers, Morse was selected as the CSIC and District 10 Coach-of-the-Year. He also gained KABC (Kansas Association of Basketball Coaches) and NAIA Area 4 recognition during the same season. In 1983-84, after leading the Tigers to the school's first-ever national championship, he was once again selected as the CSIC Coach-of-the-Year. After FHSU successfully defended its national title in 1984-85, Morse was the recipient of the following coach-of-the-year honors: NAIA, NAIA Area 3, Co-District 10, CSIC and KABC.

Morse held collegiate coaching positions at Dominican College, NY, and Alpena Community College, MI, but his coaching career really took off in 1977. Previous to taking over at the helm of the Tigers, Morse was in charge of a very successful program at Hillsdale College in Hillsdale, MI.

He is a native of Winona, MN and a graduate of Winona State University.

Ed Kozol enters his first season as an assistant coach for the Tigers with a wealth of coaching experience at nearly every level of the collegiate game. Included in his coaching record are stints at NCAA Division I and II schools, NAIA schools and junior colleges.

In addition to his coaching experiences, Kozol has most recently been an evaluator for *Juco Hoop Scoop*. While in that capacity, he served as director of operations for deep south junior college basketball.

Kozol is a native of Ft. Lauderdale, FL, and a 1972 graduate of Springfield College in Springfield, MA. While at Springfield, Kozol competed in football, basketball, baseball and rugby. His experience at the collegiate level includes jobs at Northern Montana College, Eastern Kentucky University, and South Georgia College. Kozol's only coaching job in the state of Kansas was as an assistant to Marymount College Head Coach Dan Pratt from 1981-85.


Jay Herkelman will serve in the capacity of graduate assistant coach for the Tigers in 1987. This will be Herkelman's first season at FHSU, and he brings with him two years of coaching experience at the University of Dubuque, Iowa, where he was an assistant coach.

Herkelman, a native of Clinton, Iowa, closed out his collegiate basketball career at Dubuque after playing for two years at Southeastern Community College in Burlington, Iowa. He earned a Bachelor of Science degree in communications from Dubuque in 1985, and stayed at the school until accepting his current position with FHSU.


