General Information

Rehearsal for Graduation Exercises

All degree candidates meet at 7:00 p.m. on Thursday evening, July 31, in Picken Hall and directions will be given relative to the procedure to be followed in the graduation exercises.

Academic Dress

Secure cap and gown at Business Office, Friday afternoon, July 25. Full academic dress is worn by the degree candidates on the campus only at the faculty reception, baccalaureate, and commencement. Place cap on head squarely. Women wear black dress shoes (not play shoes). Men wear white shirts. Until after the conferring of degrees wear tassel on your cap to the right front. After receiving diploma, change tassel to left side. Men remove caps during prayer, then replace. Full academic dress is worn by the faculty only at Commencement.

Processional for Commencement

All degree candidates meet in front of the Social Building at 7:45 for Commencement. Punctuality is imperative.

Commencement Dinner

All degree candidates are urged to attend the commencement dinner. Two tickets are provided for your use--one for yourself and one for another person. Additional tickets may be purchased for other members of your family and for friends at \$1.00 per plate. Make all reservations on or before Tuesday, July 29.
