## FACULTY MEETING

January 14, 1958

The Fort Hays Faculty met on January 14, 1958, in Picken Auditorium, at 4:00 p.m.

### ANNOUNCEMENTS CONCERNING SPRING SEMESTER AND ENROLLMENT

Dr. McCartney urged all advisers to see that students enroll in afternoon classes so that the load may be distributed throughout the day.

He also said that the Student Personnel Committee wants to start scheduling freshman students for next fall as soon as the tests are given next summer and it will be necessary to get the class schedule ready soon.

Dean Burnett asked all advisers to be alert to the fact that students should not sign up programs which do not leave a lunch period. This creates problems in the dining halls and should be avoided.

Mr. Dalton said that many students will enroll at the beginning of the spring semester who have not had time to have their transcripts sent to the registrar's office. They will be enrolled on "unofficial temporary permits to enroll," and that the official enrollment would come when the student has furnished the transcript.

### REPORT ON EXTENSION MEETING

Dean McCartney reported on a meeting he had attended in Topeka concerning extension classes in Kansas especially the hiring of teachers to teach the extension classes conducted by the five state colleges.
