MEMORANDUM FOR FIELD OFFICERS:

In accordance with Section 4(a) of the National Industrial Recovery Act the following certificate is required to be signed by the vendor for all open market purchases and calls on contractors either on the invoice or as a separate certificate identified with the invoice:

"It is hereby certified that in the execution of this order or contract I (or we) have complied with all provisions of the applicable code of fair competition for the trade or industry or subdivision thereof concerned approved under authority of the National Industrial Recovery Act, approved June 16, 1933 (Public No. 67, 73rd Congress), or if there be no approved code of fair competition for the trade or industry or subdivision thereof concerned, then with the provisions of the President's Reemployment Agreement promulgated under authority of Section 4(a) of that act or any amendment thereof."

The above certification should be in addition to the certificate of correctness and nonreceipt of payment and American manufacture or production of the articles.

The Finance Officers of the U. S. Army have advised that unnecessary delay in the payment of vouchers will be avoided if the procurement officers will advise the vendors that the certification must be made in connection with all purchases.

ALL NATIONAL PARKS AND MONUMENTS WITH ESTABLISHED OR PROPOSED ECW CAMPS WILL PLEASE ACKNOWLEDGE RECEIPT OF THIS MEMORANDUM.
