CIVILIAN CONSERVATION CORPS

Decision of the Comptroller General of the United States. - The following synopsis of decision of the Comptroller General of the United States is published for the information and guidance of all concerned:

Mileage - Personally-owned automobile. - Supervisory officers of the Civilian Conservation Corps may be authorized to use their personally-owned automobiles for official transportation outside of the limits of their official stations upon a mileage basis upon an administrative determination in advance that such use would be more economical and advantageous to the United States. Reimbursement for the use of their personally-owned automobiles for transportation within the limits of their official stations may not be made except upon an actual expense basis.
