**SENATE BILL No. 411**

0017 AN ACT concerning Fort Hays state university; relating to ter-  
0018 mination of the capital improvement project for a media center.  
0019

0020 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

0021 Section 1. (a) On the effective date of this act, all construc-  
0022 tion work shall cease on the capital improvement project for a  
0023 media center which is funded by the appropriation of \$375,000 in  
0024 the remodeling and additions to library basement for media  
0025 center, including equipment account of the state general fund  
0026 which was made by section 2(a) of chapter 21 of the 1978 Session  
0027 Laws of Kansas and which was reappropriated by section 2(a) of  
0028 chapter 29 of the 1979 Session Laws of Kansas and by section 2(a)  
0029 of chapter 13 of the 1980 Session Laws of Kansas.

0030 (b) No expenditures may be made on or after the effective date  
0031 of this act from the remodeling and additions to library basement  
0032 for media center, including equipment account of the state gen-  
0033 eral fund for any work on or materials purchased for such project  
0034 on or after the effective date of this act. Liquidated damages  
0035 under the construction contract related to the termination of this  
0036 project may be paid to the contractor from this account.

0037 Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after  
0038 its publication in the official state paper.
