COMMENCEMENT: The faculty members will meet for the Commencement program at 7:15 p.m., Monday, May 21, west of the West Stadium. Mr. R. Burnett will be chief marshal for the occasion.

The faculty procession will enter the East Stadium by Ramp B and divide at the top of the ramp.

The right or south column will go up Aisle IV. The first six (6) will turn left and sit in Row Two in Section C. The next six (6) will turn left into Row Three, and the next six (6) will turn left into Row Four, and the next six (6) will turn left into Row Five, and two (2) will turn left into Row Six. The next sixteen (16) will turn right into Row Two in Section D, the next sixteen (16) will turn right into Row Three, and the last sixteen (16) will turn right into Row Four.

The left or north column will go up Aisle III. The first six (6) will turn right and sit in Row Two in Section C. The next six (6) will turn right and sit in Row Three, the next six (6) will sit in Row Four, the next six (6) will sit in Row Five, and the next two (2) will sit in Row Six. The next sixteen (16) will turn left and sit in Row Two of Section D, the next sixteen (16) will turn left into Row Three, and the last sixteen (16) will turn left into Row Four.
