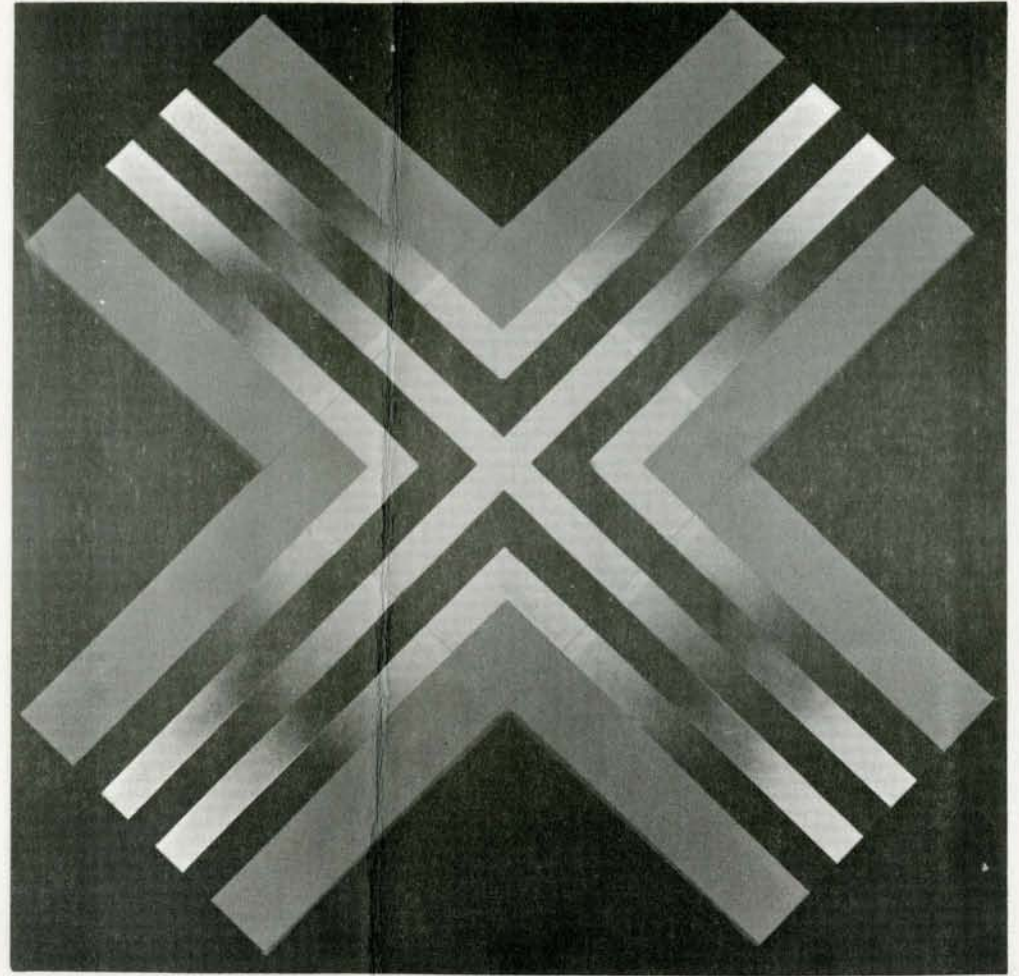

During the month of April, 1971, the Hays Arts Council is presenting its second Spring Arts Festival. The Promenade Gallery of the Memorial Union is happy to have a part of this festival of the arts. The shaped canvases and sculpture of Dr. Helen B. Davis will be on exhibition in the Promenade. Dr. Davis was selected for a second year as juror for the Smoky Hill Art Exhibition which is another event of the arts festival. Dr. Davis is Professor of Art and Chairman of the department at Temple Buell College, Denver, Colorado. She received her B.A. degree from Northwest Missouri State College; M.A. from the University of Kansas and her doctorate from the University of Denver. Currently she is working as a co-author with Dr. Eleanor Caldwell on a text: Design in the Crafts. She has exhibited in over 50 major exhibitions and is represented in numerous private collections.
