### **Perseid Meteor Shower Watch Party**

Kansas Wetlands Education Center to host Perseid Meteor Shower Watch Party August 9 at 9pm, travel to KWEC for FREE, family fun activities. The Perseid shower results when debris from the Swift-Tuttle comet enters the atmosphere. As the particles burn up, they appear as shooting stars radiating from the constellation Perseus.

Participants can rotate through activities including:

- An inflatable planetarium, which allows for viewing the sky even if the weather does not cooperate.
- Egg Drop, lunar landing STEM challenge - can you make a safe, economic lunar lander for your "eggstronaut"?
- A craft to make a constellation luminary – a good, take-home reminder.
- Glow-in-the-dark wiffle ball, a crowd favorite from years past.
- Smores, with the fire pit manned by a local Boy Scout troop.
- A "moon dust" footprint photo, in which visitors can have a photo taken of their own re-enactment of the footprints Neil Armstrong and Buzz Aldrin left 50 years ago.
- And a craft to make solar-system hats, courtesy of the Great Bend Public Library.

Once it is dark enough, visitors will be encouraged to stargaze and look for the meteor show. Bring blankets and chairs for comfort.
