Saturday afternoon/at 1:30, we will have the Commencement rehearsal for all degree candidates. We will need to have the gates to the west stadium open by one o'clock so that we can get in for our practice. We will assemble on the tracks on the west side of the field then march down the center of the field to the stage which will be on the east side of the field. Baccalaureate Services are scheduled for 8:00 P.M. at Lewis Field stadium, Sunday evening, May 28. Commencement is scheduled for 8:00 P.M., Monday evening, May 29. In the event of rain, Commencement and Baccalaureate will be held in the Coliseum. This means we will have to have a stage set up in Lewis Field and also one set up in the Coliseum.

For the Baccalaureate program, we will need to have four chairs on the stage plus a lectern and one mike on the lectern. For both Commencement and Baccalaureate, would you get the stuffed chairs from our office? For the Baccalaureate, steps may be used to get on the platform but for the Commencement, we will need a ramp on both sides. For the Commencement program, we will need twelve chairs on the stage plus a lectern and public address system for the speaker plus a stand and mike for me. In addition, we will need a table for the use of the Registrar. As in the past, we need to be sure that the stage is firm so that when the graduates walk across the stage, they do not shake the platform and interfere with the use of the mike.

As we discussed yesterday, for the graduates and faculty, we will need seventeen rows of chairs with fifty-two chairs in the first row and forty-two chairs in each of the other rows. I believe we said yesterday there should be a six foot aisle in the middle so that with the exception of the first row where we will have twenty-six chairs on each side, we will have twenty-one chairs on each side of the aisle. As we discussed yesterday, we will need to stagger the chairs to permit better viewing. In the event we come to the Coliseum, we will need twenty-three rows of chairs, twenty-four chairs to the row with an aisle down the middle, so the graduates can march in. Thus there will be twelve chairs on each side.

We need to have someone turn on the lights at 8:00 P.M. both nights for Baccalaureate and Commencement. In laying the wires for the mikes on the stage, we need to be careful not to have the wires where the graduates would be apt to trip over them.

✓ We will want to have the rest rooms cleaned in the stadium.

In the event we need to come into the Coliseum as in the past, we will need to get the maximum amount of ventilation in terms of getting the windows in the classrooms opened on the second floor and in terms of getting the fans there. If we have to come to the Coliseum, we will want to set up all of the chairs upstairs that we can.

I am enclosing the material dealing with the set-ups for the Concert Choir and the Collegian Chorale as well as the Band. As indicated in the diagram, the Band will be to the left of the stage as you face the audience and the Choir to the right. I think the chairs for the Choir could be placed directly east of the stage. After you look at these diagrams, it may be that you will need to call Dr. Bartholomew for further clarification. Thank you.

Encs. The Concert Choir and the Collegian Chorale will require one hundred twenty chairs. These could be placed in five rows, 24 chairs to the row.

There are more degree candidates than we first reported.

THE SET UP ON LEWIS FIELD WILL BE:

For Degree Candidates:

11 rows---52 chairs per row (26 on each side of aisle).

For Faculty:

5 rows---52 chairs per row (26 on each side of aisle).

THE SET UP FOR THE COLISEUM ARENA WILL BE:

23 rows of chairs with 26 chairs per row (13 chairs on each side of the center aisle).

There must also be an aisle of approximately 3 feet or more on each side of the floor.
