Before the semester officially ends, I would like to make you aware of some recent developments related to the Memorial Union.

First of all, Peter Etre has joined the ARA staff as Manager of the Memorial Union Food Service. Peter moved here last week from a similar position in the Student Union at St. Cloud, Minnesota, and is replacing Myra Leiker who recently resigned. Please join me in welcoming Peter to our campus.

During the two weeks prior to summer enrollment, the Union will be open from 8 a.m. until 4:30 p.m., Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday of each week. The Recreation Area and the Student Service Center will be closed but the Memorial Union Bookstore and the Snack Bar will be open from 9 a.m. until 3:30 p.m. The Snack Bar will provide a salad bar, hot sandwiches, sweet rolls, beverages, etc. The entire Union will be closed on Saturdays and Sundays as well as Memorial Day. We will also be closed all day Monday, May 18, because of the electrical work being completed on the campus. We will open for business on Tuesday, May 19, as soon as the electrical repairs have been completed.

You may also be interested to know the Follett Corporation has contributed \$800 to the current Development Fund campaign. ARA Services Incorporated, our Food Service Company, has agreed to again provide \$1,000 to the campaign. The gifts will be added to the "on campus" portion of the fund drive.

Finally, for those of you who may have missed the recent article in The University Leader, President Tomanek has agreed to provide over \$23,000 to the Memorial Union from the estate of Jean Stouffer to help create a lounge in the area presently known as the Promenade Art Gallery. When completed, the lounge will be dedicated to the memory of the late Jean Stouffer who for many years served Fort Hays State University in a variety of capacities. Hopefully, the lounge will be completed by the middle of the fall semester.
