Technology Services is decommissioning the old production webserver, also known as Bigcat (bigcat.fhsu.edu). Forsyth Library Opens Lobby July 7th

Forsyth Library will reopen on Tuesday, July 7th to provide basic in-person library services from the building lobby. Hours will be from 10am-1pm on Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday. Library services are available for current FHSU students, faculty, and staff with a valid Tiger Card. Masks are strongly encouraged for all persons entering the Forsyth Lobby. All persons should observe proper social distancing and hygiene protocols as indicated by signage and floor markings. Services available will include:

- **Borrowing and returning physical materials, including interlibrary loans.** Books should be reserved in advance through the [library catalog](#) for pick-up in the lobby. Sign in with a Tiger Card is required.
- **Limited and brief computer access** for research or printing only. No games or social media will be allowed.
- **Consultation with library faculty or staff.** Sessions may be arranged in advance through [Ask A Librarian](#); however consultations will take place online whenever possible.
- **TigerPrint for printing, copying and scanning.** Patrons must already have, or must create, an account and add credits using a credit or debit card to access TigerPrint. Print vouchers will not be available.

Most Forsyth Library services will remain online and available anywhere and anytime from www.fhsu.edu/library, including Ask A Librarian research help, technology assistance, interlibrary loan, and research databases / electronic resources.
