The Kansas State Legislature has just passed a bill which will provide funding for completion of the Sheridan Coliseum Project two years ahead of schedule. On April 11, 1989, at 10:00 a.m. in the Memorial Union Ballroom on the Fort Hays State University campus, Governor Mike Hayden will sign the new bill. This legislation will conclude the State's funding of 6.4 million dollars for the project.
