
Thank you very much for notifying us of your grant application before the Public Health Service to provide funds for the construction of a new Nursing School facility at Fort Hays State.

In talking to an official in the Public Health Service, I was informed that the grant application was received in the Division of Grants as of October 24 and is now in the review process. Final review of the application will take place at the next meeting of the Advisory Council March 9, 1976. At that time you will be notified as to their decision.
