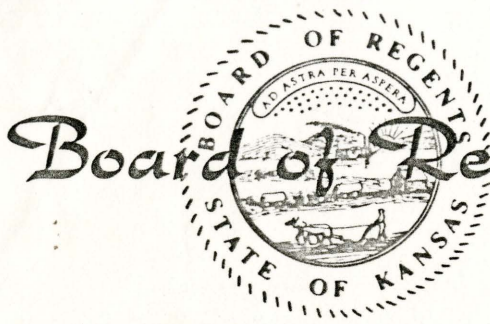

In the matter of hazard insurance on state owned buildings, it has been state of Kansas policy not to purchase commercial coverage for damages incurred by fire, flood, wind or other natural hazard. Instead, emergency allocations from the Board of Regents Special Maintenance and Repair fund are made, or in the case of catastrophic loss, the State Legislature is asked to appropriate repair and/or replacement funds. Historically, such requests have been honored as a normal part of the state's self insurance policy.

I trust that this long established Kansas practice is satisfactory.
