MINUTES OF MEETING-----DEDICATION COMMITTEE-----STROUP HALL (NURSING)

July 17, 1980, State Room, Memorial Union

PRESENT: Dr. Costigan, Dr. Zenger, Katherine Rogers, Dr. Meade, Dr. Busch,

Minutes of last meeting were approved.

A motion was made and seconded that the Nursing Alumni Organization be represented on the dedication committee. The School of Nursing should make the appointment (s).

A motion was made and seconded that President Tomanek appoint Dr. Harvey to the dedication committee. It was felt by the committee that Dr. Harvey's expertise in many areas is required for an appropriate dedication of the new facility.

Tentative dedication date is around commencement, May 15, 1980. The dedication should be the day before commencement or the day following.

The committee discussed what kind of dedication ceremony to hold. It was suggested that a formal dedication with speaker be held and that it be followed by a "health fair" of sorts where demonstrations by nurses will take place. Demonstrations such as blood pressure tests, "fat" tests, first aid, health care situations, etc.

It was suggested that at the next meeting the "theme" for the dedication be decided upon.

Bob Lowen volunteered the services of himself and Ron Pflughoft to visit with building contractors to see if they would stand the cost for a 4-color brochure of the new facility.
