- 11:45 am - Noon Sandy Rupp, Asst. to the President, meets Governor Finney and party at west door of Memorial Union
- Noon Buffet luncheon in Stouffer Lounge - 2nd Floor. Governor Finney and Anne Delaney will sit at reserved table with Regent Sidney Warner, Ed and Viv Hammond and Rep. Delbert Gross
- 1:00 p.m. Dr. Hammond makes brief remarks
- 1:15 p.m. Group walks to site of new science building behind Forsyth Library. Governor's escort may park vehicle in reserved space near site in order to leave quickly after groundbreaking to go to signing at Fort Hays Municipal Golf Course
- 1:30 p.m. Groundbreaking ceremony begins. There will be a platform on which Rev. Bill Miller, Bob Lowen, M.C., Ed Hammond, Sidney Warner and Governor Finney will be seated
- Approximately 2:00 p.m. At conclusion of remarks by speakers on the platform, there will be shovels distributed and photo opportunities "breaking ground"
- 2:20 p.m. Governor leaves with her party in her transportation to go to Fort Hays Municipal Golf Course (South Bypass). Dr. Hammond will meet her there
- 2:30 - 2:50 p.m. Signing of the bill. Nick Niernberger, Farmers State Bank, is in charge (913) 625-6542
- 3:00 p.m. Governor Finney leaves airport
