PATIENCE, PLEASE!

Favorable bids were received last week on the new Classroom and Office Building, to be located on the site of the old Rarick Hall Building. I have been advised by the general contractor, Pierce-Shippers Co. of Hays, that they intend to start preliminary site work on Monday, Sept. 25, and by the start of the following week, Oct. 2, 1978, they will be ready to enclose the site with a protective fence.

At this time a section of North Campus Drive between Park Street and the east end of Davis Hall will be closed to all university parking and traffic. I know that this will inconvenience those of you who regularly use this area to park, and I ask your understanding of the situation and cooperation.

There will be other inconveniences to all of us from time to time during the construction of this project, especially from heavy equipment noise and dust generated by the construction activity. Also, it will not always be possible to schedule utility interruptions for after normal working and class hours; to the extent that these can be controlled and scheduled in advance, we will make every effort to do so.

Finally, construction activity is generally a fascinating process to watch, but please stay outside of the fenced area for your own safety. Those of you who have legitimate reasons to visit the construction site while work is in progress should contact me at 4423 to arrange a convenient time. Hardhats will always be required within the designated project limits.
