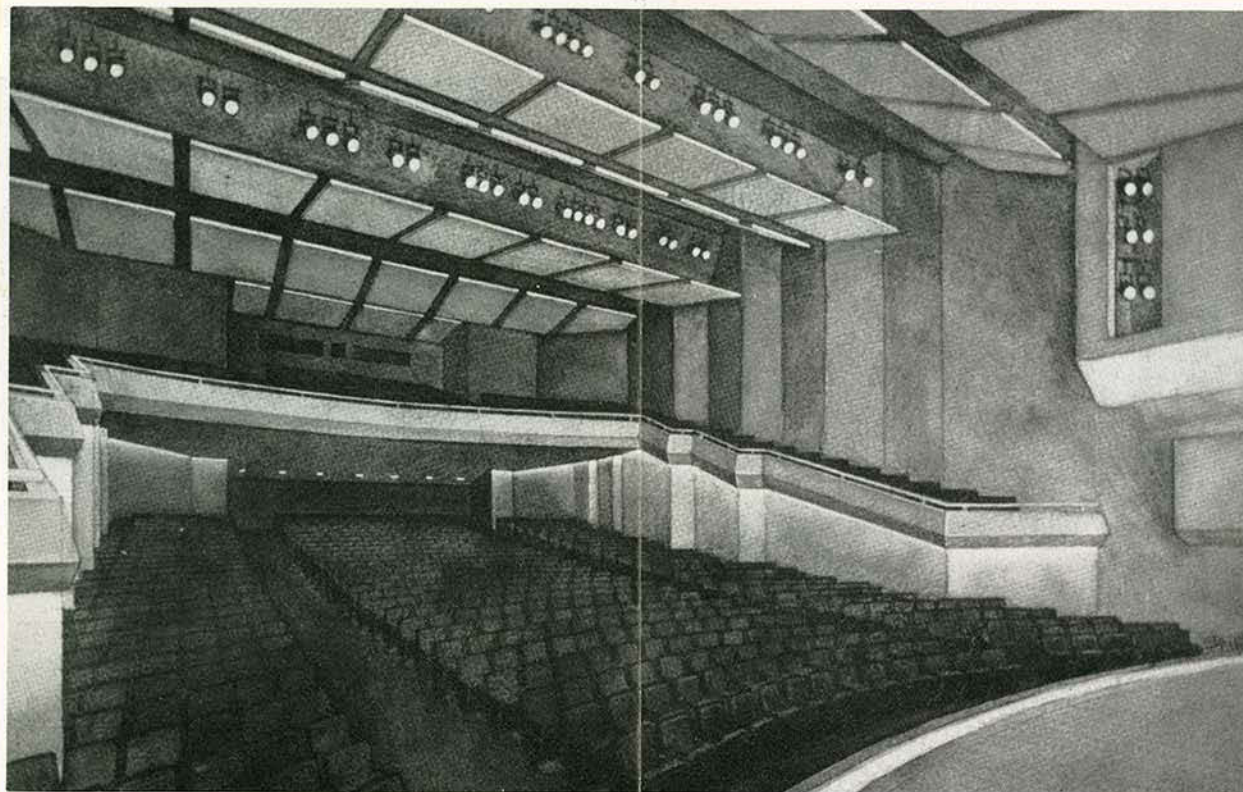

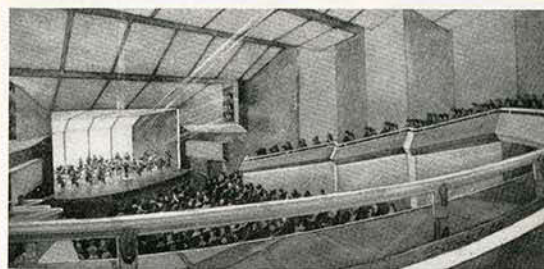
The New Performing Arts/Student Service Center
