INTERESTING FACTS ABOUT SHERIDAN COLISEUM.

1. The Convention Hall of Western Kansas at the Fort Hays Kansas Normal School.
2. Seating capacity of comfortable opera chairs 3500.
3. There are no posts to obstruct the view and every seat in the back ball is an excellent one. The Governor's box is at a point furthest from the stage.
4. The stage, the orchestra pit and

the two sections of seats in the arena may be removed and the arena used for basket ball games, live-stock shows, tractor and auto shows or for monster banquets—with spectators in the amphitheater.

5. The first time Shreridan Coliseum was used was for grand opera and standing room sold for \$1.00, with hundreds of people turned away.

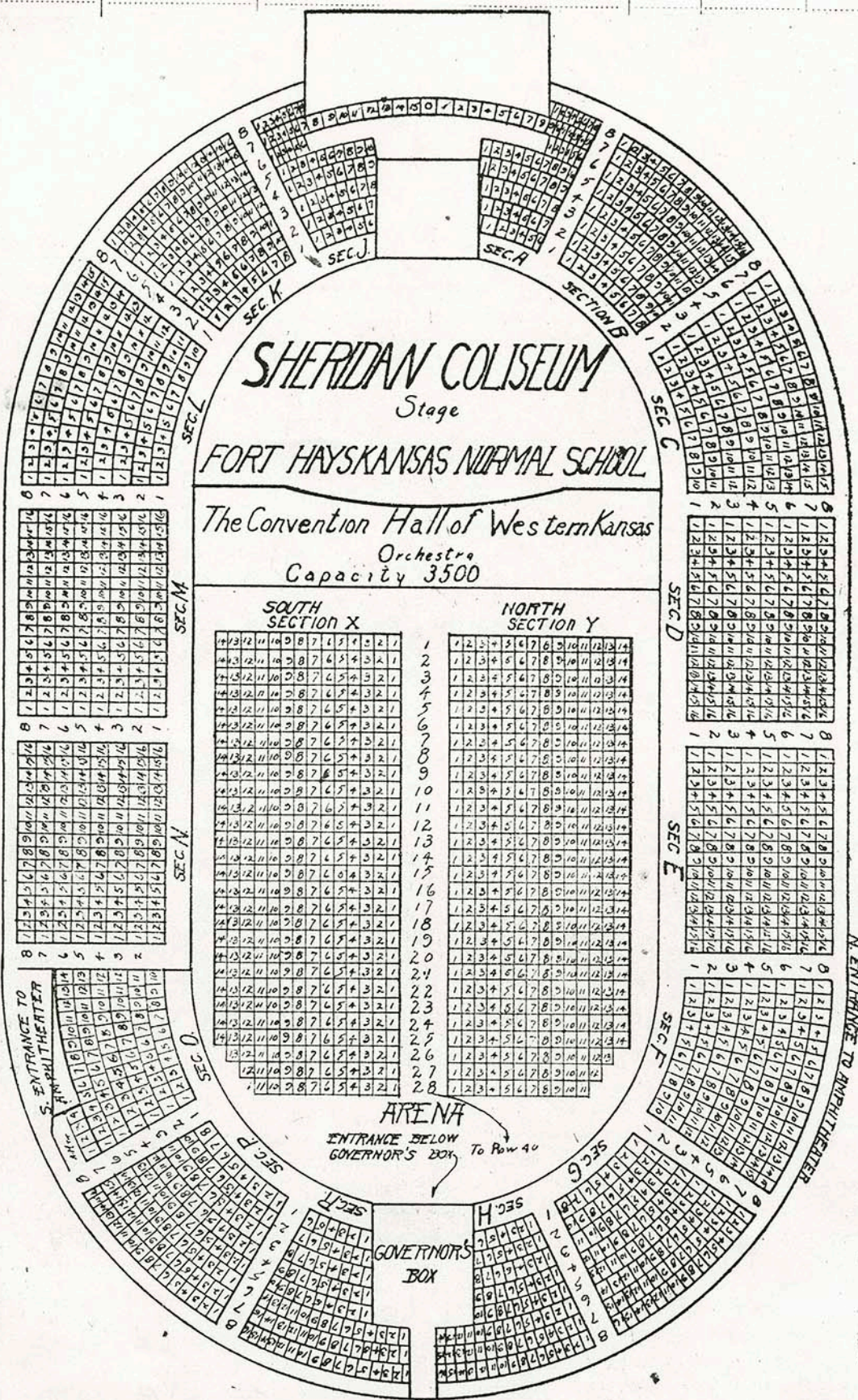
6. Music Festival Week, May 4th to 11th, will be presented in Sheridan Coliseum.
