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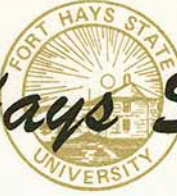



It has been brought to our attention that the 1977 Session of the Legislature passed Senate Bill No. 130, now Chapter 284 of the 1977 Session Laws of Kansas which is an act relating to historic preservation, etc.

The above is fact and the following is a rumor, but President Tomanek was concerned enough about it that he asked that I check it out. One of our retired faculty's "friends" reports that last summer a survey was made for the State listing historic buildings and that Rarick Hall was on the list.
