GROUNDBREAKING CEREMONIES FOR NEW SCIENCE BUILDING

Groundbreaking ceremonies signaling the beginning of construction on the new \$12 million physical science building at Fort Hays State University are set for 1:30 p.m., May 7.

Among the many dignitaries expected for the event are U.S. Senator Bob Dole and Kansas Governor Joan Finney.

The new, state-of-the-art facility is scheduled for occupancy during the fall of 1995. The building will house the departments of chemistry, geosciences and physics; the university's computing center; classrooms; faculty offices, and laboratories.

The site for the groundbreaking ceremonies is south of Forsyth Library near the old university tennis courts.
