1992 END OF FOOTBALL SEASON REPORT

The 1992 football season was one that started poorly, but ended up with us winning six out of our last seven games and playing the number seven team in the nation for our league championship. Final season record six wins, five losses.

I feel that scheduling four top teams early in the season is a negative for our football program. All four of our non-conference games are against schools that:

1. Have more scholarship money than we do (leads to having better players).
2. Have more money allowed in budget (enable them to do things better, like going out and recruiting better players).
3. Have full pads during spring football (enables them to challenge, work, coach and teach players under more game like situations, which better prepare them for the early part of the next season).
4. Have better facilities than we did (enable them to recruit better players).

Long trips are a necessary evil of the RMAC and our non-conference schedule. Being able to spend 20 hours on our bus and worrying about the bus breaking down, leaking fumes, losing video, burning breaks, keeping cool when it is hot and keeping warm when it is cold, is hard on the coaches and players.

After the season, I released a student coach, Randy Yard, from assisting with football. I felt he was disruptive and second guessing.

With the addition of the new playing surface and the elimination of jobs for football scholarships, I feel we will have a better chance to compete outside and inside our conference.
