Faculty Meeting

May 6, 1935, at 5:00 P. M.

Members excused: Miss Millett, Mrs. Markwell, Miss Barbour, Miss Gorham, and Miss Haggart.

Other members absent: Mr. Riley, Mr. Rouse, Mr. Start, Dr. Walker, Dr. Zinszer, Mr. Beckhelm, Miss Cruise, and Mr. Gross.

Dr. Rarick made an announcement in the change of schedule of semester examinations. He called attention to the three events to which the faculty should wear academic dress--the two services on Sunday, June 2, and commencement on Monday, June 3rd. He also asked that faculty members do not inform students of the grades which they had earned in classes given by them.

Dean Lee made an announcement concerning Freshmen and Sophomore tests to be given--freshmentests on Friday, May 24th, 8:00 to 10:30 A.M. in Picken Auditorium and Sophomore tests at the same hour in the coliseum.

The following matters were referred to the curriculum committee--first, the requirement for seniors final examination; second, the matter of students being excused from final examinations at the regular time; third, the matter of excusing students from classes for school service.

Mr. Lee announced that grades for this semester need not be in the Registrar's office until Friday following the opening of the summer school. Dr. Morris and Dr. McCartney made suggestions regarding the charge of a small fee for the giving of tests or final examinations at other than the scheduled hour. Dr. Moreland suggested his plan for make-up tests to be supervised by a graduate student for under-graduate students who were dismissed for school service.

Mr. Hobart Davis announced the Mens Glee Club Concert on Thursday evening of this week.
