Faculty Meeting

Oct. 13, 1954

Dean McCartney called the meeting to order and presented the minutes of the Faculty Senate. No action of the faculty necessary except matters in the October 6 meeting.

The faculty discussed the recommendation of the Senate concerning absence reports. (pg. 7 of Oct. 12 Faculty Bulletin) Motion was made by Mr. Welty, that this recommendation be approved. Seconded and carried.

The Dean discussed procedure for pre-enrollment for the second semester and the summer session. No action was taken by the faculty on the recommendation concerning the scheduling of three hour courses.

Motion was made, seconded and carried that the summer session schedule be set up the same as last summer.

Dr. Coder reported on the NCA workshop which he attended in Minneapolis, Minn. last summer.

Dr. Cunningham discussed the increase in enrollment for the current semester, and the percentages in each classification. He also discussed legislative budgets, KSTA sectional meeting, and announced the critical illness of Miss McGimsey.

Dr. Wooster asked the faculty association to elect the members needed to represent the faculty in WKDA and called attention to some material concerning WKDA which was available. Miss Lacey and Dr. Thomas reported that the nominating committee was functioning and that representatives to the Chamber of Commerce and W.K.D.A. would be elected by ballot shortly.
