The JIIBR Review Board now consists of over 100 faculty experts from across the business disciplines, representing numerous countries around the world.

In either event, papers should contribute an original theoretical idea and/or empirical insight to at least one of the core academic business disciplines, including accounting, finance, economics, management, marketing, international business, strategy, entrepreneurship, business law, logistics, informatics, and ethics. We seek to publish works that will be of interest to a broad business readership. JIIBR does not accept case studies. In addition, JIIBR publishes one volume per year, submissions are not reviewed and published on a rolling basis. To submit your paper, please follow JIIBR's submission procedure. JIIBR accepts submissions exclusively through the Digital Commons website. To submit your paper, please:

- 2) If you have an existing Digital Commons account, log in to your account. If you do not have a Digital Commons account, click on "Create New Account." The creation of a new account is free and very quick.
- 3) Follow the instructions, and submit your manuscript in MS Word format. Please ensure that your document is attached in Word format – any version of Word is acceptable.

The final deadline for a submission to Volume 6 is **Thursday, January 31, 2019**. Volume 6 will be published in May 2019.
